Poster sessions have been arranged in order to facilitate informal discussion and to enable more contributions to be presented than time permits for talks. Three formal poster sessions have been included in the Scientific Programme and you must ensure that your poster is manned during the session appropriate to your poster. ***Each poster will be assigned a number (eg P1) which will be notified in the Final Programme and will appear on the allotted poster board.***

POSTER DESIGN

Authors will be provided with a space 100cm wide x 118cm deep (portrait layout) on which they can mount their posters.

To be effective, a poster must be carefully designed. It should be easily legible from a distance of 2 metres. Ordinary typescript does not meet this requirement. Bold lettering is needed: a good hand-written script is often superior to type, and coloured inks also help the eye. A judicious use of diagrams, rather than continuous text, is recommended. The title and the author's name should appear as a bold heading.

DETAILS

The poster should be prepared beforehand. It may consist of a single sheet, or a set of small sheets. A photograph of the author, placed in the right hand corner of the poster, is useful for identification purposes. Fixing materials (velcro) and poster board numbers will be supplied by the organisers.
